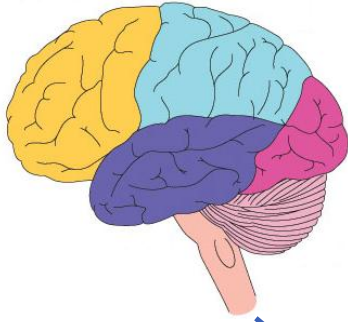

What's Involved?

- ▶ One screening visit at OHSU
- ▶ Each visit lasts 2-3 hours
- ▶ It may involve 2 visits per year for 3 years

Who's Eligible?

- ▶ Age 7 to 11 single child, or siblings in the same age range
- ▶ In good health with or without ADHD
- ▶ If taking a stimulant medication for ADHD/ADD, they must be off that medication for the testing visits
- ▶ Must be right-handed and have no permanent metal in their bodies

What Is Brain Imaging?

A brain image is obtained using a magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) scanner. It is a non-invasive machine that takes a picture of the brain. No radiation or injections. It is safe for all ages.
