Youth Villages Oregon's Intercept® program is an intensive in-home services program that specializes in:

- Providing treatment to children who have mental health, emotional and behavioral problems and their families in their own homes at times convenient for the families. These services generally occur over a four-to-six month period.
- Supporting families of all types, including: biological, adoptive, foster and friends, neighbors, etc. Our team is specially trained to meet each family where they are and work toward long-term stability, safety and health.
- Diverting youth from out-of-home placements by helping their families safely maintain youth in the home and community environment.
- Reuniting youth who have been placed out of their homes successfully. Intercept® family intervention specialists are skilled at reuniting families even when the child has been out of the home for an extended period. We reunite youth who are receiving mental health, juvenile justice or child welfare services.

ABOUT THE INTERCEPT® PROGRAM

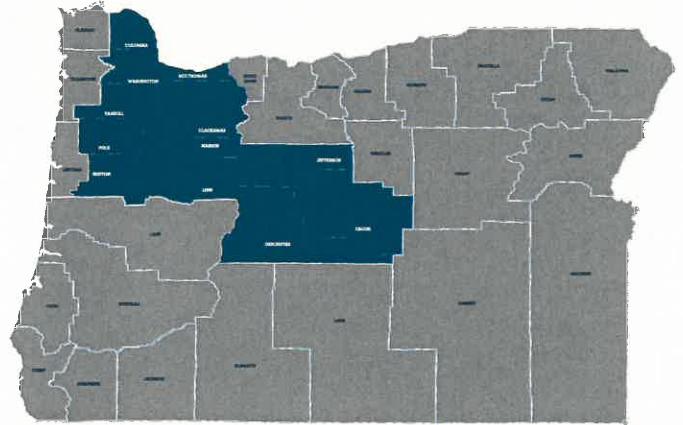
Over the past 20 years, Youth Villages has provided intensive in-home services for more than 43,000 children and families. We've helped nearly 24,000 children and families in the last eight years alone in our Intercept® program. We have demonstrated that more than 80 percent of the children who receive at least 60 days of service are successful even two years after discharge. The program is an effective alternative treatment for children and youth who otherwise would be placed in foster care, residential treatment, detention centers, hospitals or other juvenile facilities.

We provide Intercept® services to children and families in Oregon, as well as Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Indiana, Massachusetts, Mississippi, New Hampshire, North Carolina, Oklahoma and Tennessee.

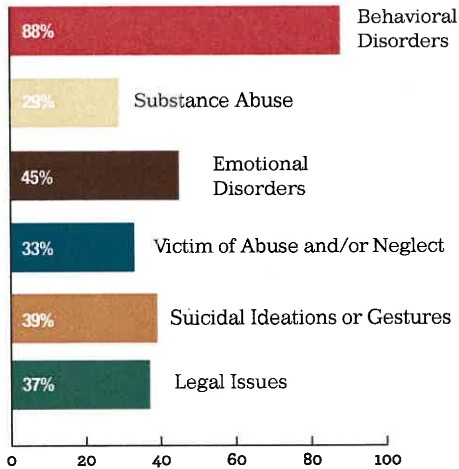


YOUTH VILLAGES INTERCEPT: SUCCESS IN NUMBERS

PRESENTING ISSUES

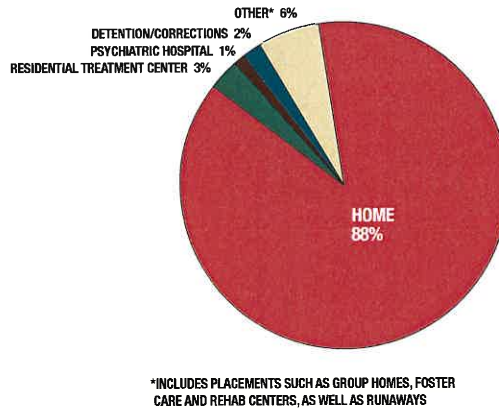
Youth served July 2006 through March 2015

SUCCESS AT FOLLOW-UP

Follow-ups conducted through March 2015

84% of youth are at home or living independently.

88% are in school, have graduated or are earning a GED.

83% have had no further involvement with the law.

YOUTH VILLAGES' FAMILY INTERVENTION SPECIALISTS OFFER VITAL SERVICES THAT INCLUDE:

- **Helping the entire family**, rather than just the child.
- Meeting with families and youth an average of three times each week and **being on call 24/7** to help the family in case of emergency.
- Working with **small caseloads** — four to six families — focusing on helping the child and family at home, in school and in the community.
- Providing a **comprehensive treatment approach** that includes family treatment, parenting skills education, educational interventions, development of positive peer groups and extensive help for families and children in accessing community resources and long-term, ongoing support.
- Identifying **specific goals and assigning measurable tasks** to the child and family. Family intervention specialists also develop targeted interventions until the family reaches the goals established in the treatment plan.
- **Engaging families** in their role of supervising and supporting their children — including consistency, discipline and communication.
- **Implementing strategies** to address aggression, problem sexual behavior and other specialized issues.
- **Collaborating with providers, case workers and courts** to formulate a collaborative treatment direction to resolve family and child issues.
- Providing **crisis prevention** and intervention.
- Conducting **extensive family searches**.
- Providing **psychiatric treatment, Collaborative Problem Solving, Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy** and Adolescent-Community Reinforcement Approach, an alcohol and drug intervention program for youth (on an as-needed basis).
- **Supporting families of all types**, including: biological, adoptive, foster and friends, neighbors, etc. Our team is specially trained to meet each family where they are and work toward long-term stability, safety and health.
